RE: GCSE Results Day – Thursday 12 August 2021

I am writing to confirm the arrangements for the collection of this summer's GCSE examination results and to provide an update on the grade awarding process this year.

To limit the number of people we have together at any one time, we will only be allowing you on site to collect your results. This means that any family members will not have access the academy.

To collect your results, you must arrive between **9am and 11.30am**. You will need to join the queuing system in the hall until you are invited through to collect your results.

There will be familiar faces to welcome and support you. Once your results have been collected, we will be providing additional support through members of staff.

The National Careers Service also has an advisory helpline. Whilst I would advise using our in-house advisor, students and their parents can contact the National Careers Service helpline on 0800 100 900.

I have attached two important documents alongside this correspondence. One is a JCQ timeline infographic which explains the national grading timeline. The second is further information regarding summer grades and the options available to appeal and resit examinations.

I am pleased to say that we have successfully passed both stage 1 and stage 2 of the JCQ quality assurance process meaning that JCQ are happy with our policy and practices surrounding the awarding of grades this year.
