### **Attendance Matters**

At Nottingham Girls' Academy we expect pupils to attend school for at least 97% of the time

1 school year at 90% attendance = 4 whole weeks of lessons missed!

90% attendance over 5 years of secondary school = half a school year missed!

Research suggests that 17 missed school days a year = A drop in GCSE grades. This is anyone on 85%.

- The same applies for university places or even job applications.

## What to do about your attendance



Attend school every day



Attend on time



If you are feeling unwell, try to attend school to see how you feel, at least you will get 1 mark rather than no marks.



All appointments should be arranged for outside of school hours and bring in medical evidence of these for your record.

### What actions we take with low attendance

Your tutor will speak with you over the reasons you have been off on your first day back. If you continue to have time off your Head of Year or Deputy Head of Year will speak to you over your attendance.

Letters of concern will be sent to your parents to bring your attendance to their attention.

You parents will be called to discuss attendance concerns. Your parents will be invited in for a meeting with your Deputy Head of Year. If your attendance continues to fall your parents may receive a penalty notice which is a fine or in some cases a prison sentence.
